

Day 1 & 2 approximate time breakdown


6am ~ We leave the hunting lodge at first light and head out into the bush and look for deer.


10:30am ~We arrive back at the lodge and spend the middle part of the day going over some theory with the aid of photos and video


12:30pm ~ Lunch break & we have a rest.

2pm~ Go over some more theory.


3pm ~ We head back out into the bush and stay out there until dark (5:30 - 6:30pm)





